




FIGURE 1 FIVE FACTORS OF LNOB: ASSESSING THE EVIDENCE OF WHO IS LEFT BEHIND AND TO WHAT DEGREE?





FIGURE 4 STEPS FOR IDENTIFYING WHY PEOPLE ARE BEING LEFT BEHIND AND WHO NEEDS TO DO WHAT

✓ MAPS: Enabling the pledge to leave no one behind via SDG mainstreaming, acceleration and policy support for national development planning

✓ Joined-up humanitarian development planning for collective outcomes




APPLICATION, INTEGRATION AND ROLL OUT

- The Guide has been formally piloted in 3 countries and used by UNCTs in many more. Based on feedback, the Guide has been updated and is now in the final stages of UNSDG endorsement.
- The key elements of the Guide have been integrated into the guidance and e-learnings on Cooperation Frameworks, MAPS etc.
- In the pipeline: integrated common learning package on HRBA, LNOB and Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment.
