Objective



- To demonstrate that forestry has development opportunities for youth to address climate change and unemployment challenges
- Encourage entrepreneurship ventures within the sector, while conserving the environment for current and future generations



Challenges



- Market Silos
 - Forestry sector working in isolation
- Skills
 - Lack of access to adequate skills, knowledge & information on tree growing & value chains
- Capital
 - Limited access to land, lack of capital and intermittent financial support for youth
- Technologies
 - Poor socio-cultural orientation towards forestry technologies & innovation
- Culture
 - Poor culture of entrepreneurship in forestry amongst the youth



Opportunities



- 30% Tree Cover Goal
 - Opportunity for the youth to participate in sustainable forest conservation while improving their economic base
- Affirmative action
 - Put in place affirmative action for youth in forest matters
- Communication
 - Strengthening communication to youth in the forestry sector
- Gross Domestic Product (GDP)
 - Sector employs 50,000 people directly and another 600,000 indirectly hence green enterprises

- Dialogue to strengthen youth participation in the forestry sector (6)
- Dialogue on how youth can support sectoral, national and county government tree growing plans and activities (4)
- Gain knowledge and understanding on commercial forestry (6)
