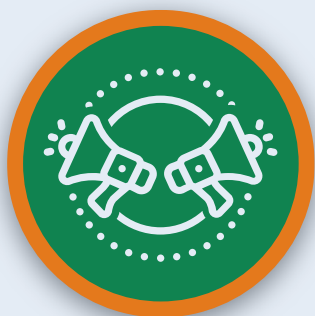

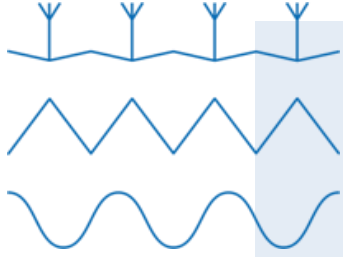

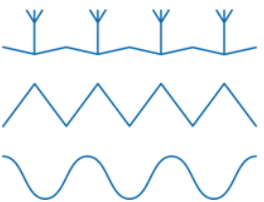

ADMIN USER

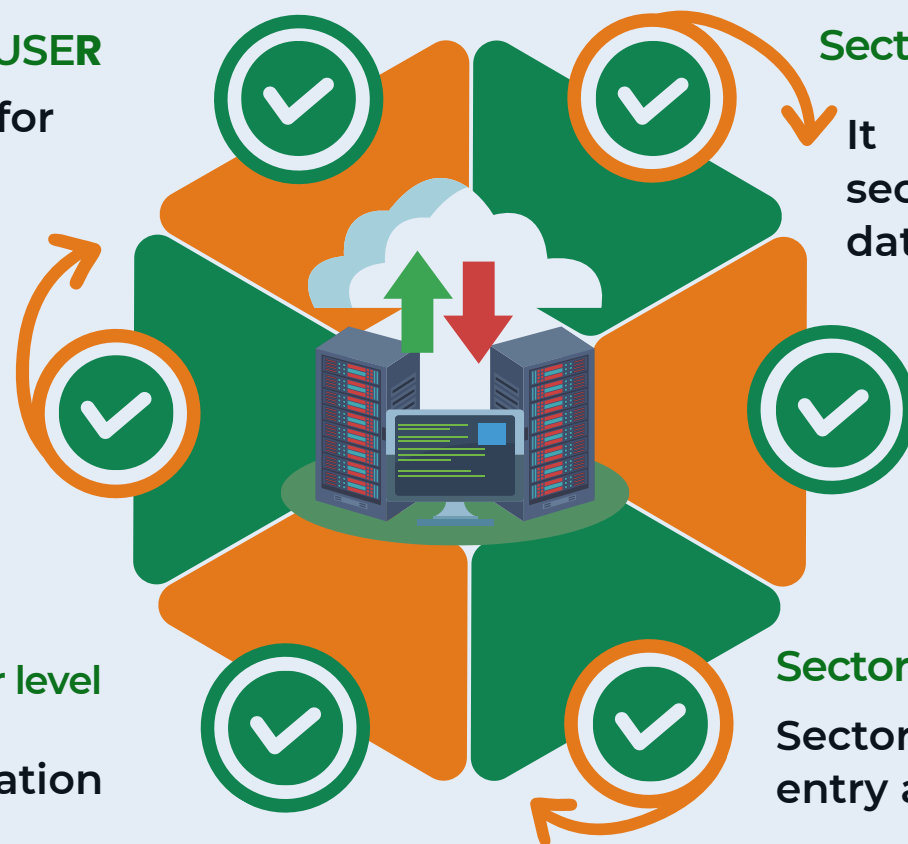
The Admin account is responsible for managing, configuring and monitoring the system, managing users, validating data.

Data entry at sectoral user level

Step of data entry awaiting validation by the administrator



Sector working group

It is the center for coordinating sectoral activities before handling data in the same sector.

QA/QC: Quality Assurance, Data Quality Control

The data authentication body before transmission to the sectoral focal point.

Sector User

Sectoral focal point responsible for data entry at the level of a specific sector.

Four Areas of Support



- ❖ **Countries' MRV and Transparency Systems Improved:** Support to ETF readiness, enhancing MRV systems for tracking emissions, develop CC modeling scenarios, NIRs, strengthen institutional arrangements and data collection, etc.
- ❖ **BTR and NC development and quality assurance:** support countries in accessing GEF funds to develop BTRs and NCs, including support on proposal preparation and quality Assurance, technical assistance in BTR and NCs drafting process, QA of reports
- ❖ **Support to Technical Expert Review and facilitative multilateral consideration of progress:** assist countries in responding to comments and recommendations of Technical Expert Review Team; incorporate recommendations from technical expert review
- ❖ **Capacity development and knowledge exchange:** national and regional training and South/South exchanges; develop knowledge products; support evidence-based policymaking

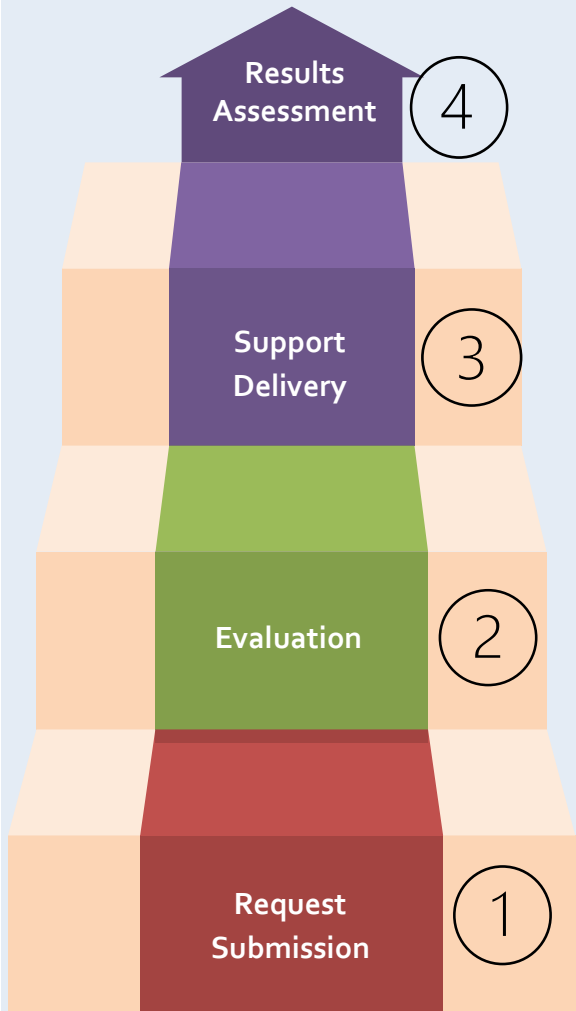

How to access the support available?



Results and achievements will be assessed and reported as part of the UNDP's transparency report.

Support will be delivered through technical workshops/missions, desk reviews, deployment of consultants or funds transferred through the Climate Promise, in collaboration with partners involved and the UNDP CO.

Received request will be evaluated and the type of support will be decided in collaboration with partners involved and the UNDP CO.

Government counterparts submit request for support from the transparency team.

Support available:

- ✓ In-country technical support and training sessions
- ✓ South-south exchanges and networking
- ✓ Regional training sessions
- ✓ Funds transferred to countries as part of their Climate Promise workplans

Key Criteria:

- ✓ First come, first serve .. But taking into account:
- ✓ Commitment and ambition of the Government, as reflected in the NDCs
- ✓ Quick assessment of delivery risks/lack thereof of ongoing bilateral and multilateral portfolio in the UNDP CO and Govt
- ✓ Alignment with country priorities and no duplication with other support

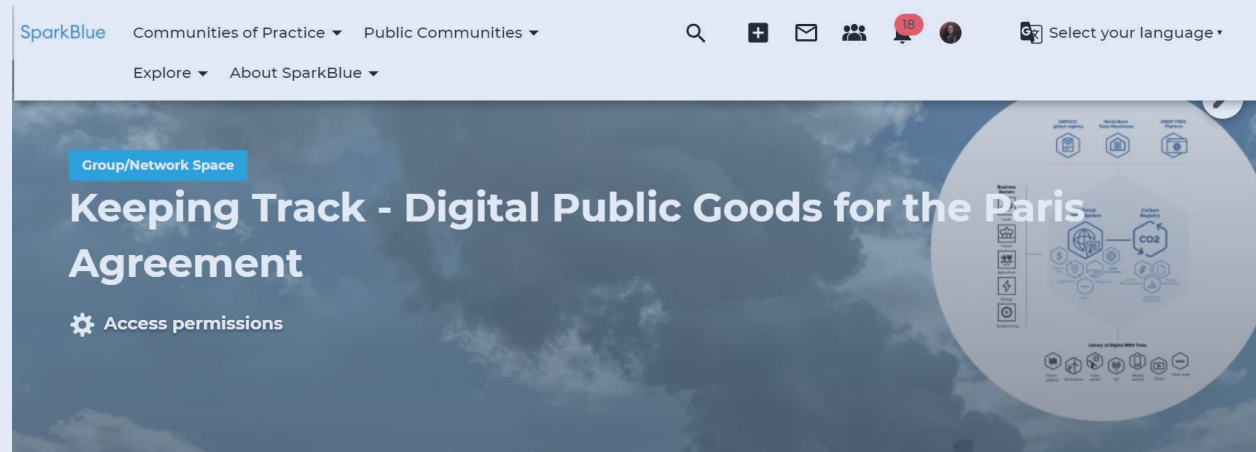

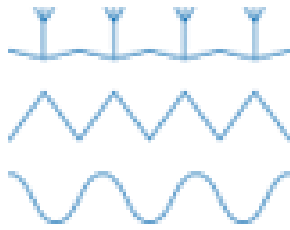
